The petitioner is aggrieved by the fact that there was a theft in respect of the vehicle belonging to him.

To that effect, an information was submitted before the police authorities but, no action has been taken.

Learned advocate for the State has submitted a report, which reflects that Samsherganj P.S. Case No. 514 of 2024 dated 07.08.2024 has been registered for investigation under the relevant Sections.

Since a case has already been
registered at the behest of the

Investigating Authorities, all efforts be taken for tracing out the vehicle and a report be submitted before jurisdictional court *in seisin* of the matter.

The police authorities will also put in all efforts for taking the investigation to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time.

With the aforesaid observations, WPA 9422 of 2024 is disposed of.

Report so submitted be kept with the record.

Let a copy of the report be handed over to the learned advocate for the petitioner.
