1. Heard Learned Lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. No firearm was recovered from the petitioner. Investigation is complete.
3. Accordingly we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail him.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that he shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

5. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.
