C.R.M. (A) 1349 of 2024

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Kotwali (Krishnanagar, Nadia)** P.S. Case No. 1156 of 2022 dated 11.11.2022 under Sections 436/307 of the Indian Penal Code.

1. There are no eye witness implicating the petitioner in the incident.
2. Apparently, there are long standing disputes between the private parties.
3. Under such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer once in a week till the conclusion of the investigation. The petitioner shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the Jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the

presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
6. C.R.M (A). 1349 of 2024 is disposed of.
