In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Gaighata** Police Station Case No.**47 of 2023** dated **17.01.2023** under Sections **498A/306/406** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, subsequently charge sheet submitted under Sections **498A/306/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 pending before the Court of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Bangaon, North 24-Parganas. (G.R. Case No.118 of 2023)

1. Husband was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court.
2. Police filed charge sheet.
3. Materials in the case diary do not suggest requirement of placing the petitioners who are the in-laws of the victim, in custody at this stage.
4. Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order

to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

6. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.
7. **C.R.M. (A) 1268 of 2024** is disposed of.
