C.R.M.(A) 1289 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Mohanpur** Police Station Case No. **196** of **2023** dated **18.08.2023** under Sections **498A, 304B, 302 and 34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Sections **3** and **4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, pending before the Court of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Datan, Paschim Medinipur.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Other co-accused was granted bail.

Police filed charge-sheet.

Apparently, the petitioner was at a different place when the incident occurred.

Apparently, the victim committed suicide.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on

condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 1289 of 2024 is disposed of.
