C.R.M.(A) 1301 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Asansol South** Police Station Case No. **373** of **2023** dated **22.10.2023** under Sections **448/341/506/304** of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Court of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Asansol, Paschim Bardhaman.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Police completed investigation and submitted charge-sheet *inter alia* under Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code as against the petitioners, after conducting the investigation *inter alia* under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code thereof.

Materials in the Case Diary do not suggest requirement of placing the petitioner in custody at this stage.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 1301 of 2024 is disposed of.
