1. Petitioners before us are not named by the injured victim, as the assailants inflicting the injury that the victim suffered.
2. Police filed charge sheet.
3. Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the Jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of

the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

5. This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
6. C.R.M (A) 1354 of 2024 is disposed of.
