In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Nandakumar** Police Station Case No.**108 of 2024** dated **21.02.2024** under Sections **323/341/447/448/506/307/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Police filed charge-sheet.

Injury suffered was not classified as grievous hurt.

Materials in the case diary does not suggest requirement of placing the petitioner in custody at this stage.

Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and, in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 1394 of 2024 is, thus, disposed of.
