The grievance of the petitioner is that Criminal Misc. Case No.587 of 2022 which is an application for cancellation of bail is pending before the learned District and Sessions Judge, Howrah since the year 2022. The said case arises out of Bally Police Station Case No.72 of 2021 dated 14.04.2021.

Having regard to the fact that the application for cancellation of bail has been pending for a considerable period of time, I direct the learned sessions court to dispose of the same within a period of 60 days from the date of communication of the order by issuing notices upon all the affected parties.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 1617 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
