In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Sutahata** Police Station Case No. **229** of **2023** dated **25.06.2023** under Sections **307/323/325/326/354/379/447/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code Charge Sheet has been submitted vide Charge Sheet No.75 of 2024 dated February 29, 2024 under Sections 447/323/325/326/307/354/379/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Court of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Haldia at Purba Midnapore.

Earlier application of the petitioner was dismissed as not pressed.

Four other co-accused were granted anticipatory bail by this Court from time to time.

Claim of parity with such co-accused is not being disputed on behalf of the State.

Police filed charge-sheet.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of

like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 1412 of 2024 is disposed of.
