In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Frezarganj Costal** Police Station Sundarban Police FIR No. 34/24 dated **05.04.2024** under Sections **341/323/354/379/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code pending before the Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kakdwip.

There subsists disputes between the parties as landlord and tenant.

Injury suffered is not grievous hurt. Materials do not suggest requirement of putting the petitioners in custody at this stage.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner no. 1 will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and

the petitioner nos. 2 & 3 will report before the Investigating Officer once a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation. The petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
