**C.R.M.(A) 1544 of 2024**

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Taherpur** Police Station Case No. **192/2024** dated **16/04/2024** under Sections **376/506** of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Ranaghat, Nadia.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Petitioner, State and the de facto complainant are represented.

In compliance of our earlier order State informed the de facto complainant, who is represented in Court.

There are police complaints at the behest of the de facto complainant.

De facto complainant recorded her statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code where she claimed that she was raped by the petitioner.

De facto complainant refused to undergo medical examination.

Allegations remain largely uncorroborated at this stage.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once in a week till the conclusion of investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 1544 of 2024 is disposed of.
