C.R.M.(A) 1564 of 2024

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Kotwali** Police Station Case No. **1065** of **2023** dated **29.10.2023** under Sections **302/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, subsequently Charge sheet submitted under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nadia at Krishnagar.

And

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Police concluded investigation and submitted charge-sheet *inter alia* under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 after conducting the investigation *inter alia* under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, thereof.

As to whether, the petitioners before us abetted in the commission of suicide may be decided at the trial.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two

sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 1564 of 2024 is disposed of.
