Husband is not implicated in this police case.

Petitioners before us are in-laws.

Apparently, the victim committed suicide.

Allegations as against the petitioners appear to be omnibus and general in nature so far as the torture is concerned.

As to whether the petitioners abetted the commission of the suicide, may be decided at the trial.

Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the

satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner no. 1 will report before the Investigating Officer once in a week till the conclusion of the investigation and the petitioner nos. 2 & 3 will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation. The petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
