1. Claim for parity with the other co-accuseds who were enlarged on anticipatory bail by the order dated April 29, 2024 passed in CRM (A) 1484 of 2024 and order dated April 26, 2024 passed in CRM (A) 1468 of 2024 is not being disputed on behalf of the State.
2. In such circumstances, we extend the same facility to the petitioners.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in

default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

4. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.
5. **C.R.M. (A) 1624 of 2024** is disposed of.
