In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Kaliganj** Police Station Case No. **182 of 2024** dated **24.02.2024** under Sections **341/326/325/307/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section **4** of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

All the petitioners before us stand implicated by the survivor who recorded her statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

Not only does the survivor speak of sexual assault but also administering poison on her. Medical examination tends to corroborate the statement made by the survivor.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners in the incident, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.

CRM(A) 1707 of 2024 is disposed of.
