The instant revisional application has been filed for quashing of the proceeding being Complaint Case No.25015 of 2010 under Sections 420/406/120B of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 8th Court at Calcutta.

Perused the contentions of the petition along with the annexed documents.

The learned Metropolitan Magistrate 8th Court at Calcutta did not comply with the provisions of Section 202 of the Criminal Procedure Code, which is mandatory prior to issuance of summons.

Under such circumstances, the instant revisional application is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to comply with the provisions of Section 202 of the Criminal Procedure Code.
