This instant case has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of proceeding of GR Case No.3491 of 2015 corresponding to Baruipur P.S. Case No. 425 of 2015 dated 13.03.2015 under Sections 447/323/379/354B/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baruipur, 24-Parganas (South) and GR Case No. 1610 of 2015 and GR Case No. 1614 of 2015 arising out of G.D.Entry No. 2034 dated 22.02.2015.
