The petitioners have submitted representations in this regard before the concerned authority (annexure P-6 to

the writ petition), which are yet to be considered. The petitioners pray for a direction upon the authority to consider the representations submitted by them at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the State respondents submits that the 3rd respondent be directed to consider the representations in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of directing the 3rd respondent to consider and dispose of the representations submitted by the petitioners (annexure P-6 to the writ petition) within three months from the date of communication of this order upon affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to all the interested persons including the petitioners, in accordance with law.

In the event the petitioners are entitled to compensation, such compensation be disbursed in their favour within two months thereafter.

There shall, however, be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit is invited, the allegations contained in the petition are deemed not to be admitted.
