Order dictated by Apurba Sinha Ray, J.

- 1) Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that he is standing on the same footing with the other co-accused persons who were granted bail by this Court.
- 2) Learned counsel for the State has raised objection. According to her, there are sufficient incriminating evidence against the present petitioner. She refers to the deposition of PW-1, PW-2 and PW-3. She prays for rejection of the prayer for bail.
- 3) We have considered the earlier order as well as the material-on-record including the deposition of witnesses. We find sufficient incriminating evidences against the present petitioner. The present petitioner does not stand on the same footing with the other co-accused persons.
- 4) In view of the aforesaid, we are not inclined to entertain the petitioner's prayer for bail.

5) CRM (DB) 1732 of 2024 is dismissed.
