Act.

Having regard to the fact that the petitioner is in custody for more than 350 days and the charge-sheet has already been submitted in this case, we are of the view that the petitioner should be enlarged on bail.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction

of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lalbagh, Murshidabad on the condition that the petitioner shall attend the trial on every date of hearing. The petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of the Islampur Police Station without leave of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lalbagh, Murshidabad. The petitioner shall notify his address to the Investigating Officer where he will reside presently and meet the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned within whose jurisdiction he shall presently reside once a fortnight until further order.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner stands **allowed**.

CRM(DB) 1751 of 2024 is **disposed of**.
