Having regard to the nature of allegations as apparent from the case records, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:-

The petitioner shall deposit 50 per cent of the finally assessed amount of Rs.4,28,690/- within a period of ten days from date before the relevant authorities of Calcutta Electric Supply Corporation Limited.

Upon such deposit, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing a bond of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. The

petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer as and when called for.

The petitioner shall comply with the conditions as stipulated in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

CRM (A) 1919 of 2024 is, accordingly, allowed.

Criminal Section is directed to supply certified copy of this order, if applied for, upon compliance of necessary formalities.
