The order proposed to be passed in the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India would not cause any prejudice to the opposite parties, as such, service of notice of the present application upon the said opposite parties is dispensed with.

The plaintiff no.1 in a suit for partition being Title Suit No. 261 of 2015 pending before the learned Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Baruipur, District : 24-Parganas (South) is the petitioner of the instant revisional application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, he is complaining delay in disposal of the application for injunction filed in the said suit.
