The petitioner has filed this application under section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 seeking quashing of the proceeding of G.R. Case no. 1079/2018 arising out of Jorabagan Police Station case no. 80 dated 02.08.2018 under sections 467/468/469/471/120B/307/506/34 of the IPC, 1860 pending before the learned Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Calcutta.
