G.R. Case No. 1629 of 2021 arising out of Amta Police Station
Case No. 186 of 2021 dated 18.07.2021 under Sections
420/406/506 of the Indian Penal Code now pending before the
Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Uluberia, Howrah.

Even on earlier occasion, no one represented the
petitioner and no accommodation has been sought for. The case
is pending since 2021.

In view of the above, this Court seems that the
petitioner is no more interested to proceed with the instant case.

Accordingly, **CRR 2041 of 2021** is dismissed for
default.
