The petitioner was granted bail by this Court on August 21, 2024, inter alia, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of Bizpore Police Station except for the purpose of attending court proceedings.

The present application has been filed seeking relaxation of the said condition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that the petitioner has violated the conditions imposed by this Court.

This Court, however, finds that the trial is on the verge of conclusion. Upon completion of the evidence, the matter has been fixed for arguments on April 8, 2026.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court is of the opinion that there is no longer any likelihood of the petitioner intimidating witnesses or tampering with evidence. Accordingly, the condition imposed upon the petitioner warrants relaxation.

Therefore, the condition that “the petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of Bizpore Police Station” stands waived.

Accordingly, **CRAN 1 of 2025** is, thus, disposed of.
