Writ petition is considered in presence of the learned advocate representing the petitioners who relies upon the order of the Hon'ble Division Bench dated 1st April, 2024 passed in two intra Court appeals being MAT 847 of 2022 and MAT 740 of 2023 which were directed against the judgment of a coordinate Bench dated 27th September, 2019. According to the petitioners in the present writ petition similar issue has been involved which was considered by the coordinate Bench while delivering judgment dated 27th September, 2019 disposing of batch of writ petitions.
