The present revisional application was last heard on 21.02.2024.

None appears for the petitioner.

The present revision of the year 2019 has been preferred against an order dated 14.06.2019 passed by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, 6<sup>th</sup> Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas, in connection with case no. N-240 of 2017 arising out of Baguiati P.S. Case No. 672 of 2017 dated 12.10.2017 under Sections 21 (b)(ii)(c)/29 of the NDPS Act.

As there is no representation on behalf of the State, let Ms. Puspita Saha, learned counsel for the State present in Court be appointed to represent the State in this case. Learned Public Prosecutor is requested to regularize her appointment.
