Learned counsel appearing for the State files a report. Learned counsel submits that all necessary steps have been taken on the basis of complaint filed by the petitioners.

Heard learned counsels appearing for the parties.

The Inspector-in-Charge of Bakultala/Joynagar Police Station, District – South 24-Parganas is directed to keep a sharp vigil at the locale, more particularly, to the property in question and to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners or their family members.

The Writ Petition being WPA 18268 of 2024 is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
