In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Nabagram Police Station Case No.213 of 2023 Dated 16.06.2023 under Sections 341/323/325/326/307/302/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 25/27 of the Arms Act

1. The petitioners renew their prayer for bail, which was rejected earlier, on merits, on more than one occasion and lastly on April 18, 2023. There is no change of circumstance since then. We do not see why we would entertain this application for bail.
2. There are prima facie incriminating materials against the petitioners. The charge is very serious. If convicted, the petitioners may face life imprisonment.
3. In view of the aforesaid, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.
4. The prayer for bail stands rejected.
5. CRM (DB) 2385 of 2024 is dismissed.

6. However, since the petitioners are in custody for about one year and four months, we direct the learned Trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date but positively within one year from the next date fixed.

7. Learned Advocate for the State tells us that there are 23 charge sheet named witnesses, but all of them may not be examined.

8. The parties shall communicate this order to the learned Trial Court.

9. All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
