This is an application for restoration of the connected writ petition which was dismissed for default on September 19, 2023.

Perused the application, it appears that the petitioner was prevented by sufficient cause from appearing before the Court when the matter was called on for hearing, the order dated September 19, 2023 is, therefore, recalled.

By the consent of the parties, the writ petition is taken up for consideration.

The petitioner participated in the 1st State Level Selection Test, 2016 for recruitment of Assistant Teachers for classes IX & X and was successful, in pursuance thereof, she was given appointment at Ghoshpur Akshoy High School (HS), Sandeshkhali, Basirhat, District- 24- Parganas (North).

The petitioner is praying general transfer on the grounds of her illness and that the distance between her residence and the school is more than 82 kilometres.

The grounds are not convincing to allow the prayer of the petitioner for general transfer, particularly when she has joined the school *only* in the year 2019.

W.P.A. 17887 of 2023 is disposed of with the above terms without any order as to costs.
