The present revisional application is being moved for the first time.

The present revision of the year 2019 has been preferred praying for expeditious disposal of the proceeding passed by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, 6th Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas, in connection with N. Case No. 241 of 2016 arising out of Madhyamgram P.S. Case No. 726 of 2016 dated 08.12.2016 under Sections 20(b)(ii)/29 of the NDPS Act.
