The present revision of the year 2019 has been preferred praying for expeditious disposal of the proceeding in N. Case No. 71 of 2018 arising out of Barasat P.S. Case No. 228 of 2018 dated 04.04.2018 under Section 21(c) of the NDPS Act, pending before the learned District and Sessions Judge, 6th Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.
