1. Heard learned advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Quantity of narcotics recovered is of intermediate quantity. Investigation is complete. Co-accused has been enlarged on bail.
3. Accordingly, we are inclined to grant same relief to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Asansol, Paschim Bardhaman subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on each and every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.
5. In the event petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the Trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail without any further reference to this Court.
6. The application for bail is, thus, allowed and disposed of.
