A representation has been made by the petitioner seeking compensation which is pending consideration.

Without entering into the merits of the prayer of the petitioner, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the competent authority of WBSEDCL in the zone to take into consideration the prayer of the petitioner and dispose of the same in accordance with law by passing a reasoned order at the earliest but positively within a period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order.
