1. Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today be taken on record.

2. The petitioner has applied for transfer on the ground of distance and her minor children. The petitioner working at Garali Netaji High School, Haringhata in the District of Nadia. He seeks transfer to a School nearby his residence at Chandernanagore, Hooghly.

3. In those circumstances, the School and the District Inspector of Schools (SE), Nadia shall consider the petitioner's application for transfer and take a decision in the matter mandatorily and positively, within a period of ten days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. If the District Inspector of Schools (SE), Nadia finds that the petitioner's application is within the Rules in

question, he shall take further steps to refer the matter to the School Service Commission.

5. The entire process as aforesaid shall be carried out offline.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant writ petition shall stand disposed of.

7. There will be no order as to costs.
