Case No.159 of 2024 dated 16.03.2024 under Sections 363/365 of the Indian Penal Code and adding Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and charge sheet submitted under Sections 364/365 of the Indian Penal Code and adding Sections 302/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners are in custody for 136 days. They have been implicated on the ground of suspicion. Co-accused viz., Swapan Khan @ Safar Khan @ Sefa Khan has been enlarged on bail.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to extend the same privilege to the petitioners also.
4. Accordingly, the petitioners viz., **Sabikul Khan @ Sabu @ Sarikul Khan and Roni Khan** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lalbagh, Murshidabad subject to condition that

they shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event the petitioners fail to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

6. This application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
