Case No.86 of 2024 dated 23.06.2024 under Sections 366A/376 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the POCSO Act and Section 10 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Statement of the victim is exonerative in nature.
3. In view of the aforesaid, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Sultan Midday** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the POCSO Act, Baruipur, South 24-Paraganas subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every

date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

6. This application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
