The present revisional application has been preferred against the order dated 21.06.2022 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court – III, Barasat, North 24 Parganas in Sessions Case No. 289 of 2021 arising out of G.R. Case No. 2835 of 2018 in connection with Bongaon G.R.P.S. Case No. 50 of 2018 dated 15.08.2018 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

At this stage the learned Advocate-on-record for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not wish to proceed with the case and that the case may be dismissed for non-prosecution.
