Records reflect that on 20.09.2023 when the revisional application was called, none represented the petitioner. Today, when the revisional application has been called, also nobody represented the petitioner.

The revisional application was preferred challenging the proceedings arising out of Domjur Police Station Case No.244 of 2022 (G.R. Case No.1781 of 2022). More than 1½ years have passed since the initiation of the present revisional application.
