The petitioners applied for mutual transfer. Their
application is pending consideration at the end of the
District Primary School Council, Nadia.

Without going into the merits of the application,
the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the
District Primary School Council, Nadia to consider the
said application in accordance with law, at the earliest,
but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of
communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be
passed and communicated to the petitioners
immediately thereafter.

As the petitioners have already put in more than two years of service, accordingly, the Board will not insist upon production of the letter of confirmation to the petitioners at the time of consideration of the application seeking transfer.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application for seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
