5. The proceeding before the trial court is for re-trial under Section 498A/494 of the Indian Penal Code.
6. Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of with the direction that the learned Magistrate shall attempt to complete the re-trial within a period of six months from the date of communication of this order in accordance with law.
