Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the suit for eviction was filed against the petitioner and in that case applications under Sections 7(1) and 7(2) of the West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act, 1997 was refused by the learned Trial Court and being aggrieved, the petitioner preferred a revisional application before this Court, being CO 1658 of 2024.
