1. We have heard learned counsel for the parties so represented.

The prayer sought for in the writ petition is to restrain the respondent no. 6 from certifying or approving the Cinematography titled "The Diary of West Bengal". Admittedly, the said film has been certified and has also been released. In any event, if any person has any reservation of watching the said film, it is well open to such person not to watch.

circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to entertain this writ petition and the same stands **dismissed**.
