Pursuant to the previous order dated 21st
June, 2024 matter is taken up for consideration
when no one appears on behalf of Dhola High
School (H.S.), District-South 24 Parganas in spite
of service of notice.

On perusal of page 17 of the writ petition, it
appears that the transfer on the ground of distance
has been rejected by the aforesaid school authority
on adopting resolution dated 21st February, 2022.

The learned advocate representing the
concerned District Inspector of Schools has placed

the learned advocate representing the petitioner.
