1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner is the sister-in-law of the victim lady. She is in custody for more than four years. Co-accused husband and father-in-law have been enlarged on bail. Petitioner is entitled to similar treatment.
3. Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned CJM Nadia at Krishnanagar on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.
4. In the event he fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail automatically without reference to this court.
5. The application being CRM (DB) 2735 of 2024 is disposed of.
