1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the matter, the marriage had taken place between the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant.
3. The learned counsel for the *de facto* complainant admits that the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant have married in the meantime and the marriage certificate dated 20.08.2024 is produced in court.
4. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, we are of the view that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner, namely, **Asraful** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.2,000/-, with one surety, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the

conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, corresponding to Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.

6. The petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer as and when required.
7. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is disposed of.
8. The marriage certificate is kept on record.
9. All parties shall act on the server copy of this order duly downloaded from the official website of this Court.
