1. Leave granted to the advocate on record of the petitioner to implead the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education as party respondent in the instant writ petition.

2. The formality of serving further copy upon the added respondent stands dispensed with as the Board is duly represented by the learned advocate.

3. Affidavit-of-service filed today be kept with the records.

4. The application filed by the petitioners seeking mutual transfer is pending consideration at the end of the West Bengal Board of Primary Education.

5. Without going into the merits of the said application, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary

Education to take a decision on the said application in accordance with law at the earliest but positively within a period of ninety days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the parties immediately thereafter.

6. The petitioner no. 2 has put in more than two years in service but is yet to receive the confirmation letter. The Board shall not insist the petitioner no. 2 to produce the confirmation letter for consideration of the application for transfer.

7. The Board shall seek the necessary information as regards the status of the teachers and the vacancy statement from the concerned District Primary School Council who shall immediately transfer the required data to the Board for compliance of the direction passed hereinabove.

8. Learned advocate for the petitioners shall forward a copy of the application seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communication of this order.

9. The writ petition stands disposed of.

10. Urgent certified photocopy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties expeditiously on compliance of usual legal formalities.
