Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record.

None appears for the private respondents despite service.

The petitioner claims to be the recorded owner of the plot in question and submits that the private respondents have raised unauthorised construction by encroaching upon a portion of the PWD land adjoining his property, thereby obstructing his egress and ingress. The petitioner submitted a representation in this regard before the concerned authority on 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 which is yet to be considered. The petitioner prays for a direction upon the authority to consider the representation at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the State respondents submits that the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent be directed to consider the representation in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of directing the 8<sup>th</sup> respondent to consider and dispose of the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 within three months from the date of communication of this order upon affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to all interested persons including the petitioner and the private respondents, in accordance with law.

There shall be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit has been invited, allegations contained in the writ petition shall be deemed not to have been admitted.
