Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.

Three primary teachers have jointly filed a composite application before the Secretary, West Bengal Board of Primary Education seeking mutual transfer. The same is pending consideration.

Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Secretary, West Bengal Board of

Primary Education to consider the said application in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

As the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 have already put in more than two years of service, accordingly, the Board will not insist upon production of the letter of confirmation from the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 at the time of consideration of the application seeking transfer.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application for seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
